Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff & Administrator of Sally Mallory do invest the sum of three thousand dollars moneys in his hands belonging to his intestates estate, in Confederate States Bonds or State Bonds of either of the Confederate States or in real or personal property at his discretion for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto.

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff & Administrator of Jesse Turner do invest the sum of two hundred dollars moneys in his hands belonging to his intestates estate, in Confederate States Bonds or State Bonds of either of the Confederate States or in real or personal property at his discretion for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto.

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff & Administrator of Henry Jones do invest the sum of two hundred dollars moneys in his hands belonging to his intestates estate, in Confederate States Bonds or State Bonds of either of the Confederate States or in real or personal property at his discretion for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto.

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff & Administrator of Mary Reese invest the sum of Six hundred dollars moneys in his hands as such Administrator in Confederate States Bonds or State Bonds of either of the Confederate States or in real or personal property at his discretion for the benefit of the said Mary Reese.

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff & Administrator do deliver with the Will annexed of Elizabeth A. Little do invest the sum of Eighteen hundred dollars moneys in his hands belonging to her intestates estate, in Confederate States Bonds or State Bonds of either of the Confederate States or in real or personal property at his discretion for the benefit of the persons entitled thereto.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning ten O'clock.

Whereas the County Court is informed that provisions consisting of Corn, Bacon & other articles belonging to the Confederate Government are deposited at different points in the County and endangered by their present position, We the County Court do order the Sheriff to take immediate possession of any and all such articles wherever he may find them and to hold them subject to our order and to make report of such proceedings above and send and if any individuals have removed any part of such provisions already, the Sheriff is hereby ordered to take possession thereof or suffer or suffer them at his discretion with the individuals so holding them subject to the order of this Court and if any such provisions be removed he is ordered to furnish Mr. J. W. Harrison purchasing agent for the indigent families of Soldiers for the 3^d Congressional District any supplies which he may wish for the district for the next two months and we the County Court do in the name of Southampton County assume any and all responsibility which may arise from any proceeding in virtue of this order.
