

Mills H Johnson & John Johnson who stand charged with a felony by their coming into this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court, in this Court, that they did on the 25th day of December 1864, in the said County, unlawfully and feloniously kill and murder by shooting with a pistol, a slave belonging to John Delaney, who this day is in the custody of the Sheriff of this County, and the Court having heard the evidence on the part of the State, do hereby order that the said Mills H & John Johnson be held to bail for the offence of which they stand charged before the Circuit Court of this County.

The said Mills H Johnson & John Johnson moved the Court to be allowed to enter into a recognizance with security for their appearance before the said Circuit Court, which motion the Court did not grant, but allowed the said Mills H Johnson & John Johnson to enter into such recognizances themselves in the sum of One hundred dollars each with sufficient security, each in the like sum of One hundred dollars, and thereupon the said Mills H Johnson & John Johnson entered into a recognizance in the sum of One hundred dollars the said John Johnson & Mr. W. Dwyer, their securities in a like sum, conditioned for the appearance of the said Mills H & John Johnson before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next term thereof, to answer the indictment of and concerning the offence whereunto they stand charged and to be absent without the leave of the said Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
