

Mills H Johnson & John Johnson who stand charged with a felony by them committed in the County and within the jurisdiction of this Court, in their intent, that they did on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1864, in the said County, maliciously and unlawfully kill and murder by shooting with a pistol a slave belonging to John D. Maysick on this day - were led to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and the Court having heard the evidence on both sides that the said Mills H & John Johnson stand charged to be tried for the offence of which they stand charged before the Circuit Court of this County. The said Mills H Johnson & John Johnson moved the Court to be allowed to enter into a recognizance with security for their appearance before the said Circuit Court, which motion the Court not allowed the said Mills H Johnson & John Johnson to enter into such recognizance without giving each of them One hundred dollars each with sufficient security each on the like sum of One hundred dollars, whereupon the said Mills H Johnson, entered into a recognizance on the sum of One hundred dollars & Mr W. D. Burd, of this town, in a like sum, conditioned for the appearance of the said Mills H & John Johnson before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of January, to answer the Commissioner of all concerning the offence wherewith they stand charged without the leave of the said Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
