

which was removed from the County to a place of safety, by an order of this Court made on the 19th day of May 1862, and for the purpose of defraying the expenses of being back, said Decree he is authorizing to borrow on the faith of the County a sum sufficient for that purpose not to exceed the sum of five hundred Dollars and he is authorized to assign the bond of the County for the sum so borrowed to the Comptroller by the preceding Justice of this County.

There vacancies existing in District No. 3 of this County by reason of the Justice refusing to commission E. R. Gray, Wm. E. Beale and Benjamin C. Lowell Justice elected on the 3rd day of August 1861 in the number of Justices of the peace for said District. It is ordered that a writ of election be issued to hold an election to fill said vacancies on the 14th Thursday in September next. And Selige Caroon is appointed Conductor and Oliver M. Bryant, Benjamin Bryant, Robert Barnes, John B. Jenkins, and Thomas R. Warrall Commissioners to hold said election.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term
