

W. L. Brown who was on the 3rd day of August 1865, duly elected as Justice of the peace in District No. 3 and J. M. Corbett in District No. 2 in this County pursuant to a proclamation of the Governor dated 29th June 1865, to fill vacancies in said Districts. This day appeared in Court and qualified by taking the several oaths prescribed by law.

James D. Gordon is appointed Surveyor of the road from Newmarket bridge to Good Water road in the name of J. G. Jones expired; and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that Samuel Kell, Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Wm. A. Gould dec^d. and administer the same according to law.

On the motion of Benj. C. Drew, who made oath and together with John J. Holmes, John Gorton, Robt. Gorton, & William D. Butler, of the County of Cumberland, (who justified on oaths as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged before him in the presence of thirty thousand Dollars committed according to law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Benj. L. Drew dec^d. in due form.

Ordered that J. D. Gorton, James Freeman, Nathaniel Hart, G. G. Birds and Jos. W. Hart, or any three of them, being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Benj. L. Drew dec^d. that may be produced to them and return the same under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered Samuel R. Kell, presiding Justice, J. D. Gorton, Thomas Laint, C. C. Mainer, Miles L. Gray, John Gorton, Jos. G. Crampton, James B. Vigneland, Franklin G. Child, Edward Benton, James G. Jones, Justices and John C. Griffin Justice.

Henry V. Cobb who was on the 3rd day of August 1865, duly elected as Justice of the peace in District No. 4 in this County. Pursuant to a proclamation of the Governor to fill a vacancy in said District created by a proclamation of the Governor of the 29th June 1865 and duly commissioned by the Governor. This day appeared in Court and qualified by taking the several oaths prescribed by law.
