The Court proceeding to fix the rates of charges at Doctor's Cart made the following allowance: For Wagon & 4 Horses 25¢ Horse & buggy or sulley 10¢ Horse & man 10¢ Foot Passengers 5¢ and Wagon & 2 Horses 25¢.

Wm. Hale is appointed Surveyor of the road from Berrett bridge to branch bridge across Black Swamp in the town of Thos. D. Dythe resigned and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Jesse Harwood is appointed Surveyor of the road from the State line to Smiths Ferry in the town of Wm. D. Bryant resigned. and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.
