On the motion of William H. Campbell who made oath and together with James R. Gardner his Security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the sum of One thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of Administration on the Estate of William Gardner dec'd in due form.
