

On the motion of Isaac Sipkin who made oath as the law directs and entered into a bond in the penalty of three thousand Dollars conditioned according to law, with Jacob Lenoir and James Vaughan his sureties therein who justified on oath as to their sufficiency and which said bond being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be received, Certificate is granted the said Isaac Sipkin for obtaining a probate of administration on the estate of Martha G. Smith dec'd which estate is declared to be of the value of fifteen hundred Dollars in due form. A stamp of the U. S. internal revenue to the amount of one Dollar being affixed hereto, as also one of the same amount on the bond aforesaid.

Ordered that John R. Wiggins, Edwin Daughtry, Govin Parker and Groome Barnes, or any three of them, being first duly sworn for duty recorded in this Court, who made oath as the law directs and entered into a bond in the penalty of three thousand Dollars conditioned according to law, with Jacob Lenoir and James Vaughan, his sureties therein, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency and which said bond, being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be received) Certificate is granted the said Isaac Sipkin for obtaining a probate of the said will (the value of the said estate being declared to be of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars) in due form. A stamp of the U. S. internal revenue to the amount of one Dollar being affixed hereto, as also one of the same amount on the bond aforesaid.

Smith dec'd, which will has been recorded in this Court, who made oath as the law directs and entered into a bond in the penalty of three thousand Dollars conditioned according to law, with Jacob Lenoir and James Vaughan, his sureties therein, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency and which said bond, being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be received) Certificate is granted the said Isaac Sipkin for obtaining a probate of the said will (the value of the said estate being declared to be of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars) in due form. A stamp of the U. S. internal revenue to the amount of one Dollar being affixed hereto, as also one of the same amount on the bond aforesaid.

Wiggins, Edwin Daughtry, Govin Parker and Groome Barnes, or any three of them, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of Jacob Smith dec'd that may be produced to them and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Davis for his due and faithful administration of the estate of Madison J. Davis dec'd, and that they conceive themselves in danger of suffering thereby, and praying the Court for relief; It is ordered that the said Madison J. Davis be summoned to appear here instantly to show cause if any he can add why he should not be released to give a new bond.
