The Commissioners appointed to act to the lowest undertaker the repair of Person's mill bridge, given this day when completed this day made their report, which is ordered to be filed.

At the motion of Benjamin W. L. Gould for administration with personal estate of William G. Gould dec'd. who died intestate it being deemed that the said estate does not exceed the value of \$1000 the said Benjamin W. L. Gould make oath as the law directs and with Jas. H. Jones & Nathan Johnson his executors (who justified on such as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged along with the penalty of two hundred Dollars conditioned according to Law which bond having a stamp of the U. S. internal revenue of the amount of \$1. affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Benjamin W. L. Gould for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said William G. Gould dec'd. in due form. A stamp of the U. S. internal revenue of the amount of \$1. being affixed thereto.

Ordered that Nathan Johnson, E. E. Kibbler and James Dwyer being sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of William G. Gould dec'd. that may be produced before them and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

The Court appoint James H. Barnes guardian of Hiram Moon orphan of Henry Moon dec'd. And therupon the said James H. Barnes entered into a bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, with Mark A. James his surety therein, which bond having a stamp of the U. S. internal revenue of the amount of \$1. and being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be recorded.

Elizabeth H. Moon, orphan of Henry Moon dec'd. this day for open tenders made choice of James H. Barnes for her guardian whom the Court approves. And therupon the said James H. Barnes entered into a bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, with Mark A. James his surety therein, which bond having a stamp of the U. S. internal revenue of the amount of \$1. and being acknowledged by the obligors therein is ordered to be recorded.
