On the petition of James W. Foreman for a administration on the estate of Elizabeth Foreman de^{ce} who died intestate. It being sworn that the said estate does not exceed the value of five hundred dollars, qualified on oath as to her sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned according to law. which bond having a stamp of the United States internal revenue affixed thereto ^{to the amount of five dollars} as ordered by the records. Carlisle is granted the said James W. Foreman for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Elizabeth Foreman de^{ce} in due form. A stamp of the internal revenue of the United States to the amount of one dollar being affixed hereto.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
