

into his hands the estate of the said Mr. H. Vicks and administer the same according to law.

In the motion of James W. Freeman for a administration on the estate of Eliza Freeman deceased who died intestate it being prove that the said estate doth not exceed the value of five hundred dollars, the said James W. Freeman made with the two devisees and wife Mary B. Bailey her attorney such justifications or oaths as to her sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the United States internal revenue affixed thereto, as evidence it is recorded. Certificate is granted the said James W. Freeman for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Elizabeth Freeman deceased on the first. A stamp of the internal revenue of the United States to the amount of one dollar being affixed thereto.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
