On motion of C. F. Mosfer he having produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law he is hereby licensed to keep on Ordinary at his house at Frontstreet in this County till the 30th day of April next it appearing to the Court that the said Mosfer is a man of good character & not addicted to drunkenness or gaming

On motion of Abner P. Boney ^{Magistrate} he having produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law he is hereby granted the right to keep on Ordinary at his house in this County till the 30th day of April next it appearing to the Court that the said Boney is a man of good character & not addicted to drunkenness or gaming

On the motion of Anthony Bottom for administration on the Estate of Silby Diggs who swears that the said Estate does not exceed in value the sum of \$200. ^{\$1000 dollars} The Court ordered that the oath required by Law and with Robert A. Nelson his security who is qualified as well as his depository, which oath and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1000 conditioned as the Law directs, which bond having a N. B. State notarial seal and stamp of the Court of the said Nelson, is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Anthony Bottom for the sum of \$1000 of administration on the estate of the said Silby Diggs in and for the stamp of the N. B. State notarial seal of the Court of the said Nelson being first affixed

Or decreed that John Brown, Frederick Brown, & Boney Brown being parties to the foregoing application shall give to the Clerk of Silby Diggs his estate the sum of \$1000 under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.
