

The Commissioners appointed to sell the same to other Elton Pitt on the lands of which he had  
died day before made their report -

Ordered that Robt S. Barnes R. S. Bryant Thos D. Howell & Goodman & Miller or any three  
of them being duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Mr H. Vick &  
and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court -

John W. Dardou having died more than three months and no person having applied for administration  
thereon in his Estate it is ordered that Samuel Pitts Sheriff of the County take into his hands the estate of the  
late John W. Dardou and administer the same according to law.

Ordered that for full answer. Sam'l Ferguson Llyder & Miller being duly sworn for the purpose  
do appraise all the goods & chattels of John W. Dardou & release the appraisement under their  
hands to the Clerk of this Court -

A Vacancy existing in District No 4 in the Office of O. Poor Ordered that an Election be held  
at said District on the first Thursday in February next to elect an O. Poor to supply said Vacancy -

David H. Thomas is appointed Surveyor of the road in the name of Bay & Waller and it is

Ordered that H. Doughty of Henry Pitt, George Camp and Harrison Bratt be written to  
remind them of their making bonds to Pockablet of which Mr. Griffin is Surveyor.

Ordered that the Commissioners of roads do set to the trustee undertake the repair & rebuilding  
of Bridge bridge & make up the rest.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of  
January next to consider the propriety of granting license to Merchants to stand about  
bridges etc to expose & reject contracts made for rebuilding or repairing bridges.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to March Court and to  
lay the County Taxe.

On the motion of Josephus Turner for Administration on the Estate of John F. Gorrell late  
who deceased that the said Estate does not exceed in value the sum of \$250. The said Josephus Turner  
take the oath required by law and together with J. S. Johnson, D. H. Gagnier, John Camp his Securaries  
who justified in oath well heard sufficient, indented and acknowledged a bond in the sum of  
\$250 conditioned according to law which bond having a U. S. Bond Stamp internal revenue of the amount  
of one dollar affixed thereto, is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Josephus Turner  
for obtaining letters of Administration on the Estate of the said John F. Gorrell late in due form. Stamp of  
the U. S. internal revenue of the amount of \$1 being affixed thereto.

A Deed of bargains & Sale from William Johnson & Polly his wife to Robert Vick was  
acknowledged by the said William Johnson & wife (the being formerly acknowledged as the law doth) and  
the said Robert having a U. S. Bond Stamp of the amount of \$1000 and a deed thereon is ordered to  
be recorded.
