

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Pittsford County held at the Courthouse thereof on  
Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1816.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the first day of April next  
to furnish a list of the inhabitants of the County not exempted by law to serve as jurors for the ensuing trials  
and also to grant to merchants dealing in Provisions to include in their term the privilege of selling man-  
ual spirits or a certain share of a pint, &c. or less.

The Commissioners appointed to seize to Lucy F. Powell's executors in chancery of her deceased husband John J. Powell  
the day made their report.

Ordered that Bay & Davis, J. T. Powell, W. Hart & James H. Fox being just duly sworn for the purpose  
to apprise all the goods or chattels of Eliza Freeman do and retain the appointment under their hands to the  
use of the Court.

James Brister is appointed Surveyor of the roads from the corner of Nauvoo fence to Upper Station near Black Water  
River in the name of George A. Farber to award and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

writs pronounced) and the grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged.
