Commissioners in the County of Chancery of this Court after first posting notice thereof as required  
by law in the office of the Sheriff, proceed in the manner prescribed by the act in the  
petition mentioned to ascertain what amount is necessary for the support of Rebecca Turner de  
fendant, and what amount the debt or debts of said petitioner shall really pay to her said  
amount, and whether the sum so agreed upon shall be of principal or interest all of which he  
is directed to report to Court -

✓ When the petition of Abellion D. Butler et al. against William H. Holmes this day filed under  
the act of Assembly passed March 3 1866 the Court doth adjudge order and direct that one of the  
Commissioners in Chancery of this Court after first posting notice thereof as required by law in the office  
of the Sheriff, proceed in the manner prescribed by the act in the petition mentioned to ascertain  
what amount is necessary for the support of William H. Holmes ward of Abellion D. Butler the petitioner, and  
what amount the debt or debts of said petitioner as hereinafter agreed shall be really pay  
and whether the sum so agreed upon and shall be of the principal or interest all of which he  
is directed to report to the Court -

✓ Upon the petition of Helen A. Turner a widow this day filed under the act of the General  
Assembly passed March 3 1866 the Court doth adjudge order and direct that one of the Commissioners  
of the Court after first duly posting notice thereof ascertain what amount is necessary for the support  
of the petitioner, of what amount amongst the debts of the petitioner shall really pay to her de  
fendant, what amount thereof is principal and what part interest and the Commissioners will report to  
the Court -

✓ The last Will and testament of Henry D. Bradley was this day fully proved by the will of Just H. K.  
and ordered to be recorded
