Case heard and decided as per decree filed

On motion of Peter W. Siphonant attorney for the said John B. Siphonant for his administration in the Estate of Allen Siphonant as executor himself in danger of suffering damage by reason thereof and asking for relief. It is ordered that the said John B. Siphonant be summoned to the first day of the next Term of the Court to show cause if any he can why he should not be made a guardian with authority accordingly to law.

On the petition of David H. Thomas guardian of Mary & John B. Glend this day filed for the purpose the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that one of the Commissioners of this Court ascertain what amount is necessary for the support of each of the two infants Mary & Glend and John B. Glend for the year 1866, whether as principal or interest of their estate and also report what amount each of the debtors is to pay to the said guardian how much principal is to be paid of any and report to the Court with any matters deemed pertinent to be reported by him or any other official matter which may be required to be stated by any of the parties interested.

The Court, with the consent of the mother, doth order that one of the Overseers of the poor of this County do bind William Hensel Ricks infant child of Nancy Ricks, colored woman, to Jane W. Pottler according to law, until he attains the age of twenty one years (he was born 29th December 1847) and in the event of the death of Mrs. Pottler before said W. Hensel turn of service shall report that he finish the balance of his term with J. W. Pottler, and it is further ordered that for the service of said W. Hensel the said Jane W. Pottler pay to Nancy Ricks his mother the sum of one hundred dollars.

The Court, with the consent of the mother, doth order that one of the Overseers of the poor of this County do bind William Henry, infant son of Mary Norrell, to Jane W. Pottler according to law, until he attains the age of twenty one years (he was born the 30th May 1864) and in the event of the death of Mrs. Pottler before the expiration of the said William Henry term of service he is to serve out his term with J. W. Pottler and the Court further orders that for the service of said W. Henry the said Jane W. Pottler do pay to Mary Norrell mother of the said W. Henry one hundred dollars for the service of said W. Henry.

The Court, with the consent of the mother, doth order that one of the Overseers of the poor of this County do bind Adeline daughter of John Christophel woman of color, until she attains the age of eighteen years (she was born the 2nd of December 1845) and in the event of the death of Mrs. Pottler before the expiration of the said Adeline term of service she is to serve out her term with J. W. Pottler and the Court further orders that for the service of said Adeline the said Jane W. Pottler do pay to John Christophel her mother twenty five dollars.

The Court doth order that one of the Overseers of the poor of this County do bind Robert Thomas Hill a boy of color to Jane W. Pottler according to law until he arrives to the age of twenty one years the said Robert Thomas having heretofore been bound to Robert J. Pottler & the Indenture transferred to said Jane W. Pottler.

The Court doth order that (with the consent of the mother) one of the Overseers of the poor of this County do bind Jerry Hill infant of Amanda Hill, woman of color, of the age of eight years two months on the 8th December 1865, apprentice to Jane W. Pottler according to law until he arrives to the age of 21 years, and in the event of the death of Mrs. Pottler before the term of service expires the balance of the term is to be served out under J. W. Pottler and the mother Amanda is to receive for the service of said Jerry one hundred dollars as is agreed to.

Ex parte Thomas M. Newsum Guardian

On the petition of Thomas M. Newsum Guardian
