appeared in Court in due course of his recognizance and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this  
County and the Court having heard the evidence, are of opinion that the said William Bailey ought to be tried  
for the offence of which he stands charged before the Circuit Court of this County. The said William Bailey  
and the Court to be allowed to enter into a recognizance with security for his appearance before the said  
Court to answer the said offence which will be the last adjournment and allow the said William Bailey to  
enter into such recognizance the said William Bailey in the sum of \$100. with sufficient security in a like sum  
in addition for the appearance for the appearance of the said W. Bailey before the Judge of the Circuit Court of the  
County of Southwark on the first day of the next Term of that Court to answer the Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
officer whom it shall stand charged, and not depart without of the said Court and that upon the said Bailey with  
William Rice his Declarant entered into such recognizance.

Attest Frank Lester & John Fairchild entered into recognizance in the sum of \$50 each to appear at the
