The account of Daniel H Colts recentral proceedings in the estate of Leonard Colb dec'd & of Richard J Darden, James J Darden & Davis Barretts recentral proceedings on Richard D Dardens estate having been examined and approved in the Clerk's Office and there being no exceptions filed, they were severally examined & confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Sheldon D Butler who has been commissioned a Justice of the Peace in the 6th District in this County appeared in Court and qualified by taking the several oaths required by law.

Present. Sheldon D Butler Justice.

The Court adopts the act passed February 20th 1866 entitled "An act to prevent and punish unlawful hunting" all the acting Justices of the County having been summoned for the purpose and a majority being present.

Edison R Story who has been elected Constable in the 3rd Magisterial District in this County this day appeared in Court and with Ben. C. Pope H. L. Pope Geo. C. Pope Parker D Story W. C. Piche he consented to and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars, conditioned as the law directs, which bond having a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar is ordered to be recorded and thereupon the said Story took the several oaths required by Law.

On the motion of Jesse B. Vick & L. C. Cobb setting forth that they are bonded in this Court as security for Joshua Postlow for his administration of the estate of Mathias W. Vaughan and that they deem to be released from said security ship. It is ordered that the said Postlow be summoned to appear here & show cause if any he can why he should be released to give a new bond with security according to law. Whereupon the said Postlow appeared and acknowledged his notice of this action, and the parties being fully heard it was considered by the Court that the said Joshua Postlow execute a new bond with good security according to law, and that he also pay the costs of this action, and thereupon the said Joshua Postlow with John Postlow, Elijah Atkins & John B. Daugherty his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$2000 conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the internal revenue of the amount of One dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Henry D Bailey the Executive named in the last Will and testament of Henry D Bailey dec'd heretofore recorded in this Court, who made oath according to law and together with Ben. C. Drown P. J. Holmes & Adimus Atkinson his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1200, conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the internal revenue affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Henry D Bailey for Manner & probate of the said Will and due form a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar being also hereto affixed.

Wm. J. Scott Constable in the 6th District in this County tendered his resignation which the Court accepts.

On the motion of James J. Darden, Librell & Archdear, A. Williams, Bernech the Merchants in this County permission is hereby granted them to sell by public sale, or at private sale or a mixture thereof at their respective stores, the Court being satisfied that they are persons of good character and it was no objection to such permission being granted.
