The account of Daniel H. Cobb's mercantile proceedings on the estate of Leonard Cobb dec'd & of Richard J. Darden, James J. Darden & Davis Barretts mercantile proceedings on Richard Darden estate having law one month and upwards in the Clerks Office and there being no exception filed, they were severally examined confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Milton D. Butler who has been commissioned a Justice of the Peace in the 6th District in this County appeared in Court and qualified by taking the several oaths required by law.

The Court adopts the act passed February 20th 1866 entitled "An act to prevent and punish unlawful hunting" all the acting Justices of the County having been summoned for the purpose and a majority being present.

Edison R. Story who has been elected Constable in the 3rd Magisterial District in this County this day offered a bond and with Ben C. Pope & G. Pope, Gis C. Pope, Parker D. Story, W. E. Beck his Deputy constable into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond having a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar is ordered to be recorded and thereupon the said Story took the several oaths required by Law.

On the motion of Jeph D. Vick, & L. C. Cobb setting forth that they are bound in this County for Joshua Postle, for his administration of the estate of Matthew W. Vaughn and that they desire to be released from said security ship. It is ordered that the said Postle be summoned to appear here to this cause of any he can say he should be called to give a new bond with security according to law. Whereupon the said Postle appears and acknowledge the justice of this motion. and the parties being fully heard. It is considered by the Court that the said Joshua Postle execute a new bond with good security according to law, and that he also pay this costs of this motion. and thereupon the said Joshua Postle with John Postle, Elizabeth Atkins & Jacob D. Daughtry his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into an acknowledgement of bond in the penalty of \$2,000 conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the United States internal revenue of the amount of One dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Mary D. Bailey the Executrix named in the last Will and Testament of Henry D. Bailey in her behalf recorded in this Court, who made oath according to law and together with Ben C. Pope, P. J. Holmes & Adicus Atkinson her securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1200. conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the internal revenue affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Mary D. Bailey for money - part of the said Will now due from a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of One dollar being also bonds affixed.

W. J. Scott constable in the 6th District in this County tendered his resignation which the Court accepts.

On the motion of James J. Darden, Schroll & Stickler, A. Williams, Branch the Merchants in this County unanimously hereby grant them to all hydraulic iron, ordnance spars or a measure thereof at their respective stores, the court being satisfied that they are persons of good character and it sees no objection to such property being granted.
