On the motion of D. H. Jagger against Thomas Sam. adms'r of Wilson Willson dec'd to create a new bond with security this day came the parties who being fully heard it is considered by the Court that the said Sam. create a new bond with security for his administration of the Estate of the said Willson and the said Sam. him or Court refusing to execute the said bond it is ordered that his powers & duties as administrator as of record be revoked & annulled and that he pay the costs of this motion.

Ordered that Samuel Kelle Sheriff of this County take into his hands the Estate of Wilson Willson dec'd as administered by Thomas Sam. former administrator and administer the same according to law.

John & Seth is appointed Surveyor of the road from Mill Springburg's hill to Connells Signpost in the town of H. T. Sett required & ordered that she usual bond work thereon.

Erasmus Spry is appointed Surveyor of the road called the Whig road in the town of South Adams and it is ordered that she usual bond work thereon.

James D. Vick who was on the 21st May 1866 elected Constable in the 5th Magisterial District in this County this day with W. H. Briggs, C. C. Williams, James Holmes & John B. Vick his brethren entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs which bond having stamps of the internal revenue of the United States amounting to one dollar being affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. And thereupon the said James D. Vick took the several oaths required by law.

Ex parte Edwards.

Upon the petition of William Edwards Executor of Wm. Edwards and a book asking guardianship of Mary & Edwards this day filed asking the Court to provide a support for his ward for the year 1866 out of the debts due and owing of the said estate and whose collection is directed by the Statute Law. The Court with advantage order and direct that one of the Commissioners of the Court ascertain what amount is necessary for the support of the minor Mary & Edwards for the year 1866 ascertain the amount of debts due what amount each debtor is to pay towards the support of the said minor whether of principal or interest together with any other special matter deemed pertinent to be stated by the said Commissioners or which may be required to be stated by any of the parties interested.
