The defendant in this case having been duly excused, this day came the parties by their attorneys and W. H. A. & W. A. Croft, J. A. Kitchin, Chas. C. Foyner, Joshua Bryant, Augustus Campbell, Jas. H. Downing, Richard S. Ransom Henry Ferguson, Robt. A. Williams, Collin A. Ricks & W. H. Stephenson who being decided by the jury first for the defendant that he does not not unlawfully hold a detainer for the purpose in controversy. Thereafter it is considered by the Court that the said complaint is dismissed and that the defendant recover against the plaintiff his costs by him about his defense in this behalf expended.

Ordered that the Commissioners find in district No 5 a lot to be levied under the act in repair or rebuilding of the bridge over Holloway swamp near Williams store near the same when completed to make report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed at April Term last to report the probable costs of a Jail to be built for this County this day made a verbal report. Whereupon DR. Edwards Clerk of this Court is hereby ^{to} advised that proposals will be received in writing for the building a jail for this County, until the 11th day of July next. And it is ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting justices of this County to the first day of July next to consider which of the proposals, if any, shall be accepted.

On the motion of Hland. Turner Brothers ordered that the Sheriff remove all the acting justices of the County to the first day of the next term of the Court to take into consideration the propriety of granting license to Merchants to retail wine, or drink spirits & a mixture thereof -

Ordered that the Sheriff Summon all the acting Justices of this County to the first day of the next to lay the County
