It appearing, the Court that they are persons of good character and the Court has no objection to such persons being granted.

On motion of Ethelred Kitchin (for leave appearing) to do Court here exempt from the payment of Taxes there in future he being aged & infirm.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County do bind George Henry Taylor (colored) George of the age of 17 years 11 months & 9 years old. The said White to pay the said George \$8. annually the said Henry \$5 annually during their apprenticeship.

This day came the parties in their proper persons and the Defendant acknowledged the plaintiffs are entitled to the possession of the premises, referred to in the proceedings & therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiffs recover the possession of the same and that a writ of possession issue therefor. But the plaintiffs agree to suspend the issuing of such writ till 1st January next and do hereby relinquish a bond for \$300 & all claims they held against said Defendant - and ordered that each party pay the costs.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County do bind George Adams to J. B. Bailey according to law, the said Bailey to pay said George at the expiration of the apprenticeship \$100.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County do bind Edith aged 13 years Hal 9 years old & Ellis 7 years old to George Brumell according to law, the said George Brumell to pay the apprentices at the expiration of their apprenticeship that is to say Edith \$50 & Hal & Ellis \$100 each.

John B. Barrett is appointed Surveyor of roads from botham road by Barrett's way up through to the Upper line in room of Stuart Branch and ordered that the road be laid out thereon.

Ordered that the road of which The Joyner is Surveyor be extended from Black creek bridge to Joyner's bridge near at James Adams and that the road be laid out thereon.

Ordered that an Election be held in District No. 6 for the election of a Constable on the 1st of August next in room of James Lane to refuse to qualify on the 1st of August.
