On the motion of Claude Turner alias merchant in this County they are authorized
to sell by retail at their store Wine, and spirituous or ministerial liquor up to the amount of
Eight hundred dollars from 1st June, 1866 to 30th April, 1867. It appearing that
both that they are persons of good character and the Court has no objection to such provision
being granted.

On motion of Ethelred Hobson for reasons appearing to the Court he is exempt from
the payment of taxes during his being aged & infirm.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County do bind George Henry
Tyler (also) George of the age of 6 years & Harry 8 years old, to the said Hobson
pay the tax George \$2 annually, & the said Harry \$5 annually during their apprenticeship.

This day came the parties in law before persons and due & sufficient acknowledgement
plaintiffs are entitled to the payment of the premises, referred to in the proceeding &
therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover the premises of the sum
and that a Writ of Possession issue therefor. But the plaintiff agree to suspend the
service of said writ till 1st January next and do hereby give & quit a bond for \$250 &
all claim they hold against said Defendant - and ordered that each party pay the
cost.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County bind George (also) to
J. P. Bailey according to law, the said Bailey to pay said George at the rate of
apprenticeship \$100.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County bind Edith (also) Hagan
Hagigan & Ellis 9 years old to George Brundt according to law, the said
George Brundt to pay the apprenticeship at the rate of their apprenticeship that is to say
Edith \$50 & Hal & Ellis \$100 each.

John B. Barrett was appointed Surveyor of roads from Colham road by Barrett making
Plants to the Sufix line in room of Abram Brundt and ordered that he used have
work thereon.

Ordered that the road of which The joyner is Surveyor be extended from Black
crack bridge to Joyner's bridge near at James Hobson, and that the road be
thereon.

Ordered that an election be held in District N^o 6 for the election of a constable
in said district in room of James Lane to refuse to qualify on the third Sunday
in August next.
