

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next Term to consider the reports of the Commissioners made the day of the letting of the rebuilding of a bridge across Stillman River at Jerusalem.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next Term to lay the County levy.

Samuel Kells who was at the 24 day of May last duly elected Sheriff of this County for the term of two years commencing on the first day of January 1867 and after the said term of office shall have expired until his successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of the office this day appeared in Court and together with A. D. Stephenson, Elliott & Henry Lamb, B. Kells, Milton D. Butler, W. H. Bartlow & John Bartlow his personal representatives entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs, wherein bond having a stamp of the internal revenue of the amount of one dollar is ordered to be recorded. And thereupon the said Samuel Kells took the several oaths required by law.

The Court after receiving the proposals made for building a jail for this County accepted the proposal of J. D. Bartlow & W. Urquhart of \$2999, and J. H. Wells, Jas. D. Bryant & J. D. Deas & James Holmes are appointed to reduce to writing a contract between the said J. D. Bartlow, W. Urquhart and the County and take bond with security of the said J. D. Bartlow & W. Urquhart according to law & when on the said contract there is a stated term of the Court they are also required to advertise & sell the old timber & brick of the old jail on some day of the next day.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till first day of next Term.
