

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next Term to consider the reports of the Commissioners made this day of the building of a bridge across Still-way River at Jesselton.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next Term to lay the County levy.

Samuel Hells who was on the 24 day of May last duly elected Sheriff of this County for the term of two years commencing on the first day of January 1867, and after the said term of office shall have expired until his successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of his office this day appeared in Court and to gather with A. G. Chapman, Elliott C. Story, Saml. D. Hells, Milton D. Butler, Wm. H. Postle & John Postle his associates entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of thirty thousand dollars, conditioned as follows, which bond bearing a stamp of the internal revenue of the amount of one dollar is ordered to be recorded, and therefore the said Samuel Hells binds the several oaths required by law—

The Court after examining the proposals made for building a jail for this County accepted the proposal of J. D. Postle & Wm. Urquhart of £2999¹⁰ and H. M. McMe. Jas. D. Bryant & D. D. Doty & James Holmes are appointed to reduce to writing a contract between the said J. D. Postle & Wm. Urquhart and the County and take bond with security of the said J. D. Postle & Wm. Urquhart according to law upon the said contract being so drawn from the Court, they are also required to advertise & sell the old timber & brick of the old jail on some County Court Day.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till first day of next Term
