

will pay to the said Schroll as Guardian for the sum of \$50 - that James A. Bell and George Warren Edwards will pay to the said Schroll as Guardian of Benjamin W. Schroll the sum of \$1,967 - that H. Schroll will pay to the said Schroll as said Guardian the sum of \$70.75 - that James further adjudge, order and decree that the debts above named pay to the said James & Schroll the costs incurred in this petition.

Ordered that Mary, James Whitfield, colored girl, 8 years old be bound by our Overseer of the Poor to James G. Jones until she attains the age of 18. The said Jones to pay to the Overseer of the Poor \$5 per year except for the last year which shall be paid to said apprentices at the expiration of her term of service.

Ordered that Antoinette Summerville, colored, aged 26 years be bound by our Overseer of the Poor to James G. Jones until she attains the age of 18 years, and that the said Jones from the time the girl arrives at the age of 9 years, pay five dollars per year until the arrival at the age of 9 years until the arrival to the age of 18 years.

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor of this County bind William Brown colored boy to George W. Spring according to law, that the said Spring pay \$5 per year for 8 years, and \$35 to the said Poor Board for the three last years of his apprenticeship.

This Court agreeing with the Court of Isle of Wight County as to the building of bridge across the Black Water River to set the bridge at Franklin. Provide bridge and Franklin's bridge - let the aforesaid James G. Jones, D. L. Stiles & R. B. Proctor Commissioners on behalf of this County to act with Government aforesaid, or by appointment by the County Court of Isle of Wight County, to let to the lowest bidder take the rebuilding of the bridge aforesaid, record the name when completed and make report to Court.

Ordered that the Estate of Elizancy Walling doth be committed to the hands of Samuel Wells Sheriff of this County to be administered according to law.

James G. Wells is appointed Surveyor of the road from the bridge at the Rail Road to William Edwards in name of James Wells son, and it is ordered that the usual hand work thereon.

The Court aforesaid Jackson joyner, colored, Guardian to Edith Branch, Hal Branch & Ellis Branch, colored, orphans, and therewith the said Jackson joyner with others before him his security who justified in all respects to his offspring, acknowledged and acknowledged a bond in the sum of twenty dollars, conditioned as he law directs, which bond bearing a stamp of the amount of one dollar, of the United States internal revenue, affixed thereto, is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Charles E. Bryant who made oath, and together with Richard P. Bryant, Peter B. Hunter, Robt N. Hart & James and O. Johnson his Securors, who justified on oath as to their offspring, colored, and acknowledged a bond in all sum of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond bearing a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted her for obtaining a letter of administration on the Estate of Everett Bryant doth in due form, a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar being affixed thereto.
