

will pay to the said Schell as Guardian for the said sum the sum of \$50 - that James A. Bell and George W. Lawrence will pay to James C. Schell Guardian of Benjamin W. Schell the sum of \$19.96, that H. Schell will pay to the said Schell as said Guardian the sum of \$70.72 - that James further adjudge, order and decree that the debtors above named pay to the said James C. Schell the sums mentioned in this petition.

Ordered that Mary Jones Whitefield, colored girl, 8 years old be bound by an Overseer of the poor to James G. Jones until she attains the age of 18. the said Jones to pay to the Overseer of the poor \$5 per year except for the last year which is to find her said apprentice at the expiration of her term of service.

Ordered that Antoinette Summerville, colored, aged 6 years be bound by an Overseer of the poor to James G. Jones until she attains the age of 18 years, and that the said Jones from the time the girl arrives at the age of 9 years pay five dollars per year until she arrives at the age of 9 years until then to raise her to the age of 18 years -

Ordered that one of the Overseers of the poor of this County bind William Brown, colored boy, to George W. Spring according to law, that the said Spring pay \$5 per year for 8 years ^{to the Overseer of the poor} and \$5 to the said W. Brown for the three last years of his apprenticeship.

This Court agreeing with the Court of Sale of Wright County as to the building of a bridge across the Black Water River to meet the bridge at Franklin. Overseer bridge was Frederick's brother, latter appointed James G. Jones, D. L. Stiles & R. B. Beckles Commissioners on behalf of this County to act with Commissioners appointed while appointed by the County Court of Sale of Wright County, to let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of the bridge aforesaid, and when completed make report to Court.

Ordered that the Estate of Anthony Whalley do be committed to the hands of Samuel Mills Sheriff of this County to be administered according to law.

James C. Mills is appointed Surveyor of the road from the bridge at the Rail River to Gilem's Edwards in name of James Mills do. and it is ordered that the usual bond work thereon -

The Court appointed Jackson Payne, colored, Guardian to Edith Branch, Hal Branch & Ellen Branch, colored, orphans, and thereupon the said Jackson Payne with Amos Copeland his security who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty dollars, conditioned as the law directs, which bond having a stamp of the amount of one dollar, of the United States national revenue, affixed thereto, is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Charles C. Bryant who undertakes and to gether with Richard S. Bryant, Rev. B. Hendon, R. H. Hunt & Governor O. Johnson his securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond having a stamp of the national revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted hereto for return of letters of administration on the Estate of Everett Bryant do. in due form, a stamp of the national revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar being affixed thereto.
