

Ordered that Edward Denton, Ben. B. Hinds & R. L. Maynard & Wm. M. Perkins or any three of them, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods or shares of Everett Maynard dec. that may be provided to them and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court -

The Court taking the subject into consideration, after hearing all the circumstances of the case doth set aside the appraisement made to Samuel Wells Sheriff his account of \$5218 45 cts. at the day of March Term last - and allow him in lieu thereof the sum of one thousand dollars -
