

On motion of Harrison P. Pope Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor for Sudbury
County bind to the said H. P. Pope the following colored children to the Robert Pope in his 16 year
Edward Ellsworth aged 13 years, Simon Mowry aged 13 years, James Pope aged eleven years, Tom
Pope aged 8 years. Said Pope aged 8 years and that he pay to the said Robert Pope \$10. a year
until he attains the age of 21 years, that he pay to James Pope \$10. a year until he attains the
age of 21 years, that he pay to Simon Mowry to James Pope \$25. a year until he attains the 21 years, that he
pay to Tom Pope the sum of \$20. a year until he attains the age of 21 years and that he pay
to each Pope the sum of \$20. a year until he attains the age of 21 years, the said Pope
remaining bound with good security for the payment of the said several sums of money to the said
apprentices at their attaining 21 years of age, to be discharged with the indentures.

The Court having been Summoned to consider the report of the Commissioners relative to the erection
of a bridge over Nottaway River at Jesson's in this County, proceeded to consider the majority and
minority reports made by the Commissioners appointed to let out the same. Whereupon the
contractor R. L. & J. Bryant by John J. Hinckley and Joe R. Chumbley, moved the Court to
confirm said majority report which motion was opposed by Harrison P. Pope, a citizen of said
County & holder thereof of the owner of the land on which the said bridge abuts on the West
side of said River. And on hearing the evidence produced and arguments of Counsel, the Court
did confirm the said majority report, to which opinion of the Court the said Harrison P. Pope
by his attorney acquiesced and had his bill of exceptions which was allowed signed sealed by the
Court and adjudged to be made a part of the record in this case.

The Court allow. for Harrison Miller W. Penruiter, John P. Bryant, John H. Hinckley,
John C. Wells, Phil. Boies, Wm. F. Griffin, Geo. W. Griswold, Benj. J. Bryant, David H.
Hinckley, P. J. Hinckley, Dennis Bryant, Murdoch L. Stephen, George H. Griswold, Luther
R. Edwards, Robt. Ridder, Mathew H. Stephen, C. F. Tolson & Thos. D. Bryant, fifty five
cents each for their services as jurors, due them to be paid out of the County Levy.

Ordered that the Sheriff Summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the
next Term of the Court to appear persons to be the Land possessed in this County.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning noon O'clock.
