

On motion of Harrison P Pope Ordered that one of the Overseers of the Poor for Southampton County bind to the said H. P. Pope the following colored children to wit Robert Pope in his 16 year Pope aged 9 years. Neal Pope aged 8 years and that he pay to the said Robert Pope \$40 a year until he attains the age of 21 years. that he pay to Neal Pope \$40 a year until he attains the age of 21 years that he pay to James Pope the sum of \$25 a year until he attains the age of 21 years and that he pay to Tom Pope the sum of \$20 a year until he attains the age of 21 years and that he pay to Neal Pope the sum of \$20 a year until he attains the age of 21 years. the said Pope executing bond with good security for the payment of the said several sums of money to the said apprentices at their arriving 21 years of age, to be returned with the indentures.

The Court having been summoned to consider the report of the Commissioners relations to the erection of a bridge over Hathaway River at Jamestown in this County, proceeded to consider the majority and minority reports made by the Commissioners appointed to let out the same. Whereupon the Court confirmed the majority report which motion was opposed by Harrison P Pope a citizen of said County & freeholder thereof & the owner of the land on which the said bridge abuts on the West side of said River. And on hearing the evidence produced and arguments of Counsel. The Court did confirm the said majority report: to which opinion of the Court the said Harrison P Pope by his attorney excepted and tendered his bill of exceptions which was allowed. Heigned & sealed by the Court and ordered to be made a part of the record in this case.

Adams, Dennis Bryant, Murdoch L. Stephenson, George B. Spindler, Luther R. Edwards, Robert Ridley, Mathias W. Stephenson, C. F. Dostler & The D. Boykins, fifty five cents each for their services as jurors this term, to be paid out of the County treasury.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of the County to the first day of the next term of the Court to appear in person to see the land proposed in this County.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning Nine O'Clock.
