The Commissioners appointed to examine the Black Creek Bridge this day made a report. And it is ordered that James B. Bryant and S. L. Dole, two of the Commissioners of the said County let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the said Black Creek Bridge for the same when completed.

The Commissioners appointed to examine the Bridge and the Flat Swamp on the Bryant Road, this day made their report and it is ordered that the same Commissioners, Wm. Francis & Jas. B. Bryant let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the said Bridge for the same when completed. And it is ordered that the same Commissioners be and they are to be paid for \$200.00 & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that the account of M. Hutchinson Jailor of the City of Portsmouth & of Norfolk County, which Jail has been adopted as the Jail of this County, the Jail of this County having been destroyed by fire, amounting to nearly two dollars be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

On the motion of Saml. Hells Sheriff of this County, Eli W. Davis is permitted to qualify as his Deputy, it being the opinion of the Court that he is a person of honesty, sobriety & good demeanor and therefore he took the several oaths prescribed by law.

Ordered that the amount of Samuel Hells Sheriff of this County amounting to Sixteen Dollars and Seventy five cents be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

Samuel Hells late Sheriff of this County this day produced to the Court books of capitation tax, one amounting to \$87.80 another to \$7.20 another to \$21 another to \$5. another to \$37.10 and another to \$47.20 copies of the said deputy Sheriff and duly certified by the Commissioners of the County and having been examined by the Court, and the Court being satisfied of the correctness of the same and also satisfied that copies of said lists were posted up at the Court House door of this County on a Court day during of the next Term preceding the last. It is ordered that copies thereof be certified to the first Auditor.

Ordered that the Court be a quorum till the first day of the next Term.
