The last William Foreman of William G. Stephenson dec^d was this day proved by the oaths of Samuel B. Kells and Shugars Linn Justice of the Subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be removed. And on the return of William Stephenson and Mills Stephenson the executor thereon named who made oath and together with Shugars Linn, Winthrop M. Clayton, James G. Jones and Charles Stephenson, their securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of six thousand dollars evidenced according to law, which bond having stamps of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said William Stephenson and Mills Stephenson for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form. Ordered that Shugars Linn, Eli Spring, and So. A. Hood being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of Wm G. Stephenson dec^d that may be produced to them and return the same under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.
