It appearing that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called and not appearing, whereupon it is considered by the court that plaintiff may have execution against the defendants for the sum of \$173.75 as guardian of George W. Harris and for the like sum of \$173.75 as guardian of L. L. Harris being the amounts assessed against them to pay the plaintiff, in part of a debt due from the defendants to the plaintiff as guardian aforesaid, and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

James B. Wightman, a Justice of the peace in the 7th District of this County, this day by letter int. advising tendered his resignation as a Justice aforesaid, which is accepted, and it is ordered that a writ of election be issued to the electors and townsmen of several townships divided in the said 7th District to hold an election on the 1st Saturday in November 1866 to supply said vacancy.

The Commissioners appointed at the August term of this court to act in conjunction with Commissioners appointed by Mansfield County, to let to the lowest bidder privately or publicly as they may deem best, the keeping of a ferry across Blackwater river at New South Quay for the free travel of the inhabitants of the Counties of Hanscom and Southampton for the term of one year or more not exceeding three, and report to court. This day made a report that they and the Commissioners appointed by Hanscom County court proceeded the 27th day of September last to let to the lowest bidder the keeping of the said ferry, when Wm R. Lawrence became the undertaker at two hundred and thirty dollars a year for three years, which report being considered by the court is adopted and the said ferry is established as a ferry for the free travel of the inhabitants of this County & the County of Hanscom.
