The Commissioners appointed to reduce to writing a Contract to
between Mr. Merchant J. J. D. Pittman and this County for the
building of a New jail for this County and to take of them
a land in the Penality of Six thousand Dollars conditioned
for the faithful performance of the said Contract this day
made their report which is accepted and adopted by the
Court.

A Writing bearing date the 31st day of March 1812 purporting
to be the last will and testament of John Cobb de d. was this
day produced to the Court and there being no subscriber
whom the Court could identify,
W^m W^m. Cobb and Walter White being duly
sworn deposed and say that they are well acquainted with the
handwriting of the said John Cobb de d. and firmly believe
that the said writing and the name thereon subscribed are
wholly in the handwriting of the said John Cobb de d.
and thereupon the said writing is ordered to be received
as the true last will and testament of John Cobb de d.
And W^m W^m. Cobb and W^m H. Nicholson the executors there
in named having refused to take upon themselves the burden
of the execution thereof. On the motion of Margaret Ann Cobb
who made out and together with W^m W^m. Cobb her son
is (who justified out as to his sufficiency) entered into
and acknowledged a bond in the penality of Fifty thousand Dollars
conditioned according to law, which bond having Stamps of the internal
revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar affixed
thereto is ordered to be sealed. Certificate is granted her
for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of
the said John Cobb de d. with his will annexed in due form
Stamps of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount
one dollar and fifty cents being affixed thereto.

Ordered that W^m H. Nicholson, W^m A. Bell and W^m W^m. Cobb
bring suits for the purpose to appropriate all the goods or
chattels and real estate of John Cobb de d. that may be pro-
duced to them and return the said instrument under
their hands to the Clerk of the Court.

Ordered that Saml.Hello Sheriff of this County take into
his hands the estate of Lewis Wick de d. to be ad-
ministered according to Law.
