It is ordered that an account of the poor of this County be laid to him by Edward a boy of color age 18 years until he is twenty one years of age. The Master paying for the services of the apprentice \$20.00 a year to be received to be paid him when he arrives at the age of twenty one years and the overseen of the poor by whom this sum is expended shall take bond and security of the master with good security for the payment of the same and for every at the expiration of the term of service of the apprentice and it is ordered that the master teach the apprentice to read, and write and the redemption of Antislavery, or have him taught, according to the rule of the Court.

Upon the petition of Anne M. Bell this day filed under the act of a Kentucky passed March 2^d 1836, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that one of the Commissioners of this County, after first posting notice thereof as required by law in the settlement of fiduciaries proceed in the manner required by the act in the petition mentioned to ascertain what amount is necessary for the support of the petitioner Anne M. Bell and what amount the debts or debtors to said petitioner shall ratably pay, and whether the sum so ascertained upon each shall be of the principal or interest, all which he is directed to report to Court.

The Commissioners appointed by this Court to act conjointly with Commissioners of Gravesville County to bid out to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of Hales bridge proved to the same could be paid for a sum not to exceed the sum of one thousand dollars this day made their report, which is ordered to be filed, and it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands and not otherwise appropriated pay to James H. Person and Dempsey R. Taylor the sum of \$1666.67 2/3 Six hundred and sixty six dollars and 2/3 pence And one third cents this County's proportion for the rebuilding of said bridge.

Ordered that the account of L. R. Edwards Clerk of this Court amounting to fourteen dollars be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.
