

Arrest of the person John Thompson

Ony June 20 per Deane filed.

Arrest of a person of colour, who stands charged
Parker Perry, after person of colour, who stands charged
with a felony by him committed in this, that he did on the
18th day of October 1866, in the County of Southampton,
steal of the value of thirty dollars of the goods and
chattels of William Magellan on board in the steam
vessel feloniously did steal, take and carry away
now this day sent to the bar in custody of the Sheriff
of this County, and the Court having heard the evidence
of opinion that the accused is guilty of a misdemeanor
for which he ought to be in the County Jail, at
the March term of this Court next. Therefore the said Parker
Perry was bound to be allowed to enter into recognizance
with security for his appearance before the said County Court,
which motion the Court entertained and allowed the said
Parker Perry to enter into such recognizance himself in the
sum of fifty dollars with sufficient security in a like
sum. And the said Parker Perry is remanded to jail
until he enter into such recognizance.
