at the next term of this Court to give additional
security.

Ordeletta's case ex parte - Deane
This day John Deane came on again to be heard on the
papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Howard
was presented to a decree entered at the November term
1866 of this Court and the said report having lain on
the Court for exceptions and no exceptions having been filed
thereon and was argued by Counsel, on the hearing where
the Court doth approve, order and decree that the
report of Commissioner Howard be confirmed.

The report of Commissioner Howard made in behalf of
John M. Bell in respect certain amounts to be paid to her
by debtors to her to be applied to her necessary
support, clothing &c. as provided for by the act of
the General Assembly of 1852 passed the 3rd day of
March 1866, whether and not staying the collection of
debts for a limited period, having been filed in the
Clerk's office of this Court for one month and no
exceptions having been filed thereto the said report
is approved and confirmed by the Court and it is
ordered that the said report be entered of record by the
Clerk of this Court for such further proceedings
therein as may be necessary and proper and it
is ordered that the costs be ascertained among the
debtors ratably.

Ordered that Saml. Kells Sheriff of this County take into
his hands the estate of Jacob H. Hill (colored) to be ad-
ministered according to law.

Ordered that Richard L. Bryant guardian for Joseph
B. Thorpe and John L. Thorpe, Mary Ann Thorpe, Thomas W.
the principal of each of his said wards estate of
necessary for their support and education.

Ordered that Richard L. Bryant guardian of John D.
Bryant and Eulalia Francis Ward be allowed to expend
one hundred and fifty dollars out of the principal of each
of his said wards estate, if necessary for their
support and education.
