

Ordered that one of the Orphans of the poor of this County bind as an apprentice
 to Sally Rando. Sally Rando aged 12 years - Sham Rando
 full aged ten years and Tanny Rando aged seven years free
 persons of color former slaves of the said Sally Rando (who are
 likely to become chargeable to the County. till the said Sham
 and Tanny arrive to the age of twenty one years respectively
 and the said Tanny arrive to the age of eighteen years, that
 they be taught the art Trade & mystery of a farmer,
 to read and write and common arithmetic to the value
 of three. and that the said Sally Rando pay ten Dollars
 per year during the apprenticeship of the said Sham and
 Tanny for each of them and five dollars per year for the
 said Tanny during her apprenticeship.

Ordered that an Orphan of the poor of this County bind as an apprentice
 to John A. Rindred, William Drury aged 11 years, Aaron Drury
 9 years and James Drury 8 years - the persons of color till
 they arrive respectively to the ages of 21 years. That the
 said Rindred pay to the said William \$5.00 per year for the
 first five years and Ten dollars per year for the last five
 years to Aaron and James Drury five dollars per year
 from their thirteenth year and Ten Dollars per year thereafter
 to each. The said apprentices former slaves of Edmund
 Drury and being likely to become chargeable to this County.
 they are to be taught to read and write and the art,
 Trade and mystery of a farmer.

Ordered that an Orphan of the poor of this County bind as an apprentice to
 David H. Rindred. Ben Rindred eleven years old, Abner Rindred
 nine years old and Abner Rindred five years old till they
 arrive the said Ben & Abner to twenty one years and the said
 Abner to eighteen years. That the said David H. Rindred pay
 to the said Ben five dollars per year till he is fifteen years
 old and five Dollars per year thereafter making \$75.00
 to the said Abner \$5.00 per year for the last five years
 of her apprenticeship making \$25.00 and to the said Abner
 \$5.00 per year for the last six years making \$30.00.
 The said apprentices having been former slaves of Henry W.
 Rindred and being likely to become chargeable to this County
 and they to be taught to read and write and the art, Trade
 and mystery of a farmer.

On the motion of Burton J. Davis who made oath according to Law
 and together with M. D. Butler, David Branch, Benjamin Davis &
 George A. Davis his securities, each paid for on each of the
 their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in penal
 sum of ten Dollars, conditioned according to Law, which bond
 having a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the
 amount of one dollar affixed thereto, is ordered to be recorded.
