This day this petition came out to be read, on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge and order that a commission be issued and to the Clerk report what amount is necessary for the support of the infants Lura & and George W - Harris what amount each debtor shall pay after paying the whole upon their liability of whether the same be ascertained upon each shall be of the principal or interest, under the provisions of the act of the Genl. Assembly of Virginia entitled an act to stay the collection of debts for a limited period for pass^d 2nd, March 1866.

For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that the poor of this County do bind Lucinda Knight aged 12 years and James Boykin, colored boy to Thomas D. Boykin. The said Thomas D. Boykin to the said Lucinda Knight for her services a sum of \$10.00 per annum, one half to be paid in cash at the end of each year to the apprentice and the other half to be reserved until she arrives to the age of eighteen years and that he pay for the services of James Boykin \$10.00 per year. one half to be paid to the apprentice at the end of each year and the other half to be reserved until she arrives to the age of twenty one years and the apprentices not to be taught to read and write and common arithmetic and the said trade and mystery of farmer.

For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that an overseer of the poor of this County do bind Lovetta Jenkins aged ten years to the said Jenkins. The said John H. Jenkins to pay for the services of the apprentice annually the sum of \$8.00, one half to be paid to the apprentice at the end of each year and the other half to be reserved to be paid to her when she arrives to the age of eighteen years and the apprentice is to be taught to read and write and common arithmetic and the said trade and mystery of a farmer.
