Ordered that Jas. Handley, At. J. Cobb & Jas. D. Davis being first duly sworn for the purpose
to appraise all the goods or chattels of Lucy J. Jenkins etc which may be produced or shown to them
and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.



On the motion of Lucy J. Vick who made oath according to law and together with
Samuel Kille, George W. Vick & Shugan his Sureties (who justified on oath as to their suffi-
ciency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned
as the law directs which bond bearing a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the
amount of one dollar affixed thereto is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted the said
Lucy J. Vick for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Robert H. Vick late in law
bearing a stamp of the internal revenue of the United States of the amount of one dollar being bonds
affixed.

Ordered that George L. Law, Jas. L. Gardner & Geo. W. Vick long first duly sworn
for the purpose to appraise all the goods or chattels of Robert H. Vick late and return the appre-
asment under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.
