John Moore, B. G. Evans, Levi H. Stephenson, W. H. French, David Turner, W. Atkinson, R. S. Dole, W. L. St. John Barr, Collins Ricks, John G. Barth & Joseph Gardner who being sworn did find and swear the truth to speak upon the few points upon their oaths returned a verdict in these words "We the jury find the prisoner guilty". Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said Archibald Williams be confined in the jail of this County for the term of one month and thereupon the said Archibald Williams be commanded to jail.

Allen Banks a person color who stands charged with a felony by law committed in this County on the 16th day of February 1867 feloniously break and enter the room of Joseph McPherson in the County at the night time with intent to commit larceny was this day set to stand in custody of the justice of the Court, and after being heard had the wisdom and opinion that the said Allen Banks ought to be tried for the offense of which he stands charged before the Circuit Court of this County and therefore he is remanded to jail.

Winfrey Moore a colored person who stands indicted of larceny was set to the bar in custody of the justice of the Court and pleaded not guilty to the Indictment. Whereupon came a jury to sit. John Moore, Levi H. Stephenson, W. H. French, W. Atkinson, R. S. Dole, R. H. Blythe, Collins Ricks, W. H. Bragg, Joseph Gardner, A. H. Stephenson, Eli Spring & R. F. Dardar who being sworn did find and swear the truth to speak upon the few points upon their oaths to say "We the jury find the defendant Not guilty". Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Defendant be acquitted and discharged of the offense aforesaid and that he be discharged from custody.

George Davis a person of color who stands indicted of larceny was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and pleaded not guilty to the Indictment. Whereupon came a jury to sit. John Moore, Levi H. Stephenson, W. H. French, W. Atkinson, R. S. Dole, R. H. Blythe, Collins Ricks, W. H. Bragg, Joseph Gardner, A. H. Stephenson, Eli Spring, R. F. Dardar who being sworn did find and swear the truth to speak upon the few points upon their oaths returned a verdict in the following words to wit "We the jury find the Defendant not guilty". Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Defendant be acquitted and discharged of the offense aforesaid and that he be discharged from custody.
