The Summons awarded at the last term of this Court against Harrison P. Pope to show cause why a road should not be established on his land, to lead from the embarkment or wharve end of the bridge across the highway except Atkinson River at Jourdoun to the old or former road being returned executed. The said Pope appeared by Counsel and being fully heard the Court gave upon the sum of twenty five dollars as a just compensation to the said Pope which he accepts. With the opinion of the Court consideration of the report of the viewers and all the circumstances of the case that the said road be opened according to the report of the viewers aforesaid.
