Upon the petition of Helen B. Turner an unmarried woman &c. This day this cause came on to be heard on behalf of petitioner and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof of the Court doth order that one of the Commissioners of the Court ascertain whether the petitioner is dependent for support on the income due her from E. B. Claus, J. H. Powers, Mrs. B. Powell, C. D. Barnard & S. M. Claus on account for \$1229⁰⁰ due to her by 1st March 1860. what amount shall be paid by whom, whether by instalments or at one time, & when, and make report to Court.

For reasons appearing to the Court and by consent of parties Ordered that the license granted J. R. Gair to retail liquor &c. at his store in this County be transferred to Franklin Branch merchant at Penobscot in this County. It appearing to the Court that the said Franklin Branch are men of good character.
