

A paper purporting to be the last will and testament of Robert Postler de. being presented to the Court on the 13 day of October 1865 - being presented to Court for probate and the same being admitted on the 13th day of October 1865 - that the witnesses thereto were not present together at the time of dictation and the parties interested in the estate being presented to the Court at the time of dictation (and the parties interested in the estate) by which their names and signatures of attesting paper (which were used in the paper) by consent of parties also ordered that the said paper purporting to be the last will and testament of Robert Postler de. be admitted to probate and be read as read still and testament -

James M. H. Postler entered into a recognizance for his appearance here in the first day of September to give evidence before the grand jury against E. C. H. Postler.
