

At a quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County convened held for the said County on
Saturday the 31st day of August 1867,

On the motion of Wm. H. Proctor who made oath and together with Wm. H. Cobb his surety (who justified
on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of One hundred dollars conditioned
according to law which bond is ordered to be executed - Certificate is granted him for drawing letters of administration
to be issued on the estate of Amherst B. Peppett deceased in due form. It being understood in both that the additional
and present of the said Amherst B. Peppett does not exceed in value one thousand dollars.

The Court affirmed the payment of debts contracted by the County for the support of the paupers and of the
families of indigent soldiers, between the 1st day of April 1865 & the 1st day of May 1865.
