on the estate of Amos B. Pettit deceased in due form. It being declared on oath that the estate and
personal of the said Amos B. Pettit does not exceed in value one thousand dollars.

The Court adjourned the payment of debts contracted by the County for the support of the paupers and of the
families of indigent soldiers, between the 1st day of April 1866 & the 1st day of May 1865.
