rence Conveying real estate, was admitted to record August 19<sup>th</sup> 1867.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands pay to D. L. Dales  
thirty dollars for provision furnished Rebekah Morris a pauper in 1866 and was not paid the  
month by the Officers of the Poor.

On motion of Joseph A. Darrow against Richard J. Darden, Jas. J. Darden & Aaron P. Popes. It  
appearing to the Court that the debt have had legal notice and chance of appearing Ordered that the said  
motion be continued till the next Term of this Court.

On the motions of B. Barnes & J. Lawrence Evans of Caw Boro who sue for the benefit of  
J. H. Boykin & G. M. Boykin Esqrs of F. M. Boykin Esq. against A. W. Overflat. It appearing  
to the Court the debt has had legal notice of this motion and he did appear. It is considered by the Court  
that the Plaintiff recover against the Defendant forty dollars fifty nine cents being a sum equal to the  
interest for one year on the sum of \$1000.00 principal debt due by the Defendant to the Plaintiff by J. H.  
Boykin against the Defendant in the Circuit Court of Southampton County on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1866  
in favor of the Plaintiff. And also that that the Plaintiff recover against the debt there left in his behalf unpaid.
