 Deed of Trust dated 28th November 1866, from William H. White to George M. Davis Trustee, for the benefit of David & Bass, conveying real estate, was admitted to record September 7th 1867.
 Deed of bargain & sale dated 30th September 1866, from Richard J. Darden & Caroline F. his wife & others to Harrison S. Pope, conveying real estate, was admitted to record as to Caroline F. the wife of Richard J. Darden, September 9th 1867.

J. P. Edwards Clerk of this Court ^{has been} deceased to David McKee J. H. Remington but after Commencement of said District November 1st A. D. State of Virg. the Office in the District was in immediate possession of the Office now occupied by Judge E. M. Hoffmann for the term of 12 months after said term as he shall deem best.

The Indentures dated 10th day of March 1866, binding George, Vincy and Theophilus Whitefield & their children to George Fogg by Capt. General Jeffries of the Freedmen's Bureau, were this day produced to the Court for confirmation, and on motion of George Fogg it is ordered that the same be confirmed.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands pay to S. D. Sherry dollars for provisions furnished Rebecca Morris a pauper in 1866 and was not paid therefor by the Overseer of the Poor.

On motion of Joseph S. Browning against Richard J. Darden, Jas. J. Darden & Harrison S. Pope. It appearing to the Court that the said Darden had legal notice and appeared & answered. Ordered that the said motion be continued till the next Term of this Court.

On the motion of B. Barrow & L. Lawrence Executors of Carr Barrow who sue for the benefit of J. H. Boykin & F. M. Boykin Executors of F. M. Boykin dec'd against A. M. Hoffmann. It appearing to the Court that the said Hoffmann had legal notice of this motion and he not appearing. It is considered by the Court that the said plaintiff's recover against the Defendant Forty Dollars fifty nine cents being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$1000. 77^{1/2} principal debt due by the Defendant to the plaintiff by J. H. Hoffmann & Darden against the Defendant in the Circuit Court of Southampton County on the 1st day of May 1866 in favor of the plaintiff. And also that that the said plaintiff recover against the said Hoffmann & Darden their costs in this behalf expended.
