Franklin E. Williams is appointed Surveyor of the road to the Farmers Bridge. Road to the Upper line in the town of H. M. Butts. and it is ordered that the usual laws be made thereon.

H. M. Butts is appointed Surveyor of the road from the Barr Town to the Farmers bridge.
