

Count in the settlement of his accounts the sum of \$50 per annum for the years 1865  
64, 65 & 66 for the board of Charles S. Bailey, the sum of \$24 per annum for the years  
1863, 64, 65 & 66 for the board of James S. Bailey & the sum of \$30 per annum for  
the years 1863, 64, 65 & 66 for the board of Joseph C. Bailey to be paid out of the  
principal of the said 280000 dollars.

Two writings one bearing date 10<sup>th</sup> day of 1859 and the other bearing 15<sup>th</sup> July 1862  
purporting to be the last Will Testament of Geo. F. Collier or George F. Colloff, were  
produced to the Court for perusal And there being no subscribing witness to the writing bearing  
date 10<sup>th</sup> July 1862, Mr. D. Boykin & James G. Jones being sworn severally deposed & said  
they are well acquainted with the hand writing of the said Geo. F. Collier, or Colloff, and  
they believe the writing aforesaid bearing the 15<sup>th</sup> July 1862, and the name of Geo. F. Collier  
therein subscribed is wholly in the hand writing of the said Geo. F. Collier. Whereas it is  
the opinion of the Court that accordingly ordered that the said writing bearing date the  
12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1862 be recorded as and for the true last Will and Testament of the said Geo.  
F. Collier &c. And there being no Executor named in the said Will on the return of  
Wm. H. Deane law clerk made according to law and together with Edward W. McSpensbury  
law clerk who justified in oath as to his office, entered into and acknowledged a bond  
in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered  
to be recorded. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the  
estate of Geo. F. Collier &c. with his Will aforesaid annexed in due form. It being declared in  
oath that the estate real and personal of the said Geo. F. Collier does not exceed in value the  
sum of five thousand dollars.

Ordered that the hands being on the lands of Wm. A. McSpensbury, Esq. Attorney,  
Wm. P. Moore, John Williams & Emanuel Bell do work on the road of which Wm. A.  
McSpensbury is surveyor.

Ordered that Samuel Kelle Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of  
Hastwell Pate dec'd and administer the same according to law.
